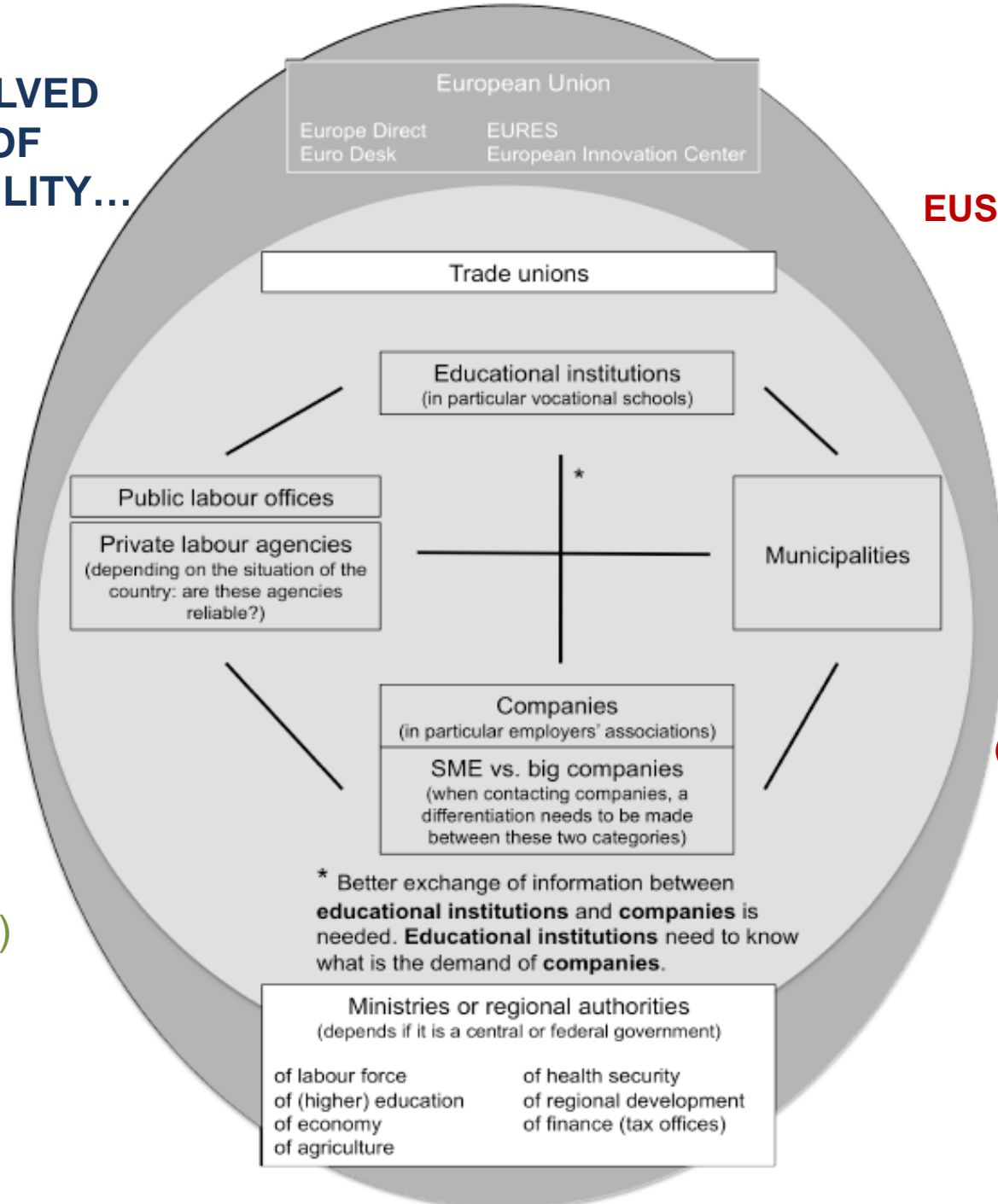

DEMANDS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

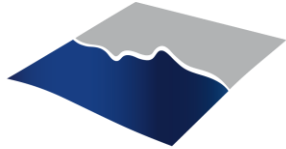
according to BSLF- Action Plan on Cross Border Mobility in the Baltic Sea Region

- a. to concentrate **support services to information centers** in every country in order to offer better services in several languages
- b. to **increase the level of information** about mobility issues
- c. to enhance and improve the **advisory service of the EURES** information centers
- d. to improve **statistics** about labour markets and mobility
- e. to work for **better regulation and monitoring** on cross-border mobility
- f. to prevent and deter **undeclared work**
